Special Exhibit Featuring Artists from Across the U.S. A Different Day Gallery Brings National Artists to the East Bay December 5, 2008 to January 31, 2009

Albany, CA— A Different Day Gallery, an art gallery devoted to promoting emerging East Bay artists, announces the opening of the gallery's first National Juried Exhibition, which opens on December 5th, 2008. A Different Day Gallery's "National Juried Exhibition" brings the artwork of prominent California and national artists together in Albany, CA. Submissions were received from all over the country from Boston to Los Angeles. The selected group exhibit features artwork by David Rose from Santa Rosa, CA; Marilia O'Donnell Lutz from Oakland, CA; Martin Rowe from Rhinelander, WI; Michelle Rial from Serena, IL; and Hannah Rosenberg from Richmond, CA.

The "A Different Day Gallery National Juried Exhibit" will be on display December 5, 2008 through January 31, 2009. The artists chosen for the National Juried Exhibit were selected from a large group of talented artists from across the country by Albany, CA-based jurors Susan Adame, and Karin C. Nelson. Ms. Adame is a past president of ACCI Gallery in Berkeley, has been involved with public art for the City of Albany for three decades, has organized art fairs for the Chamber of Commerce, and has continued her career as a fine artist during this time. Susan currently creates mixed media collages and paintings. Ms. Nelson is currently an independent curator and arts consultant who holds the position of Research Associate at the Museum of Craft and Folk Art in San Francisco. Ms. Nelson has served as a curator and coordinated numerous exhibitions, and is a member of the Public Art Advisory Committee of the Alameda County Arts Commission, representing District 5 (Albany, Berkeley, Emeryville, and North Oakland). She was also a member of the City of Albany's Arts Committee for five years. The National Juried Exhibit will showcase the artists' talent in various mediums and styles, from abstracts to landscapes.
